

School Contributions and Charges 2024

Curtin Primary School Council has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024. The schedule is broken into sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that they might incur throughout the school year.

1. Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay is \$60 per child, plus additional voluntary approved requests being \$35 per child for the Curriculum Enrichment Fee and \$20 family P&C Levy.

Contributions are voluntary, however the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximized when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

2. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities, etc. for the year has been included. Details on charges collected in previous years has formed our charges schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum charges for scheduled activities in 2024. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.

The charges schedule includes costs associated with:

- specific learning activities and available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made. eg. incursions, excursions, classroom cooking, etc.
- specific learning activities are available to selected students, but conditional on a payment being made. eg. PEAC.
- other activities available to all students, but conditional on payment being made. eg. school picnics, the graduation activities, etc.

3. Items for Personal Use in the Educational Program

The charge for personal use items will vary from student to student. Included with this notice is the list of materials your child will require for personal use in 2024. These personal items are to be supplied by parents.

Definitions

Contributions: This means 'voluntary contributions'. The term relates to the monies requested from parents towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by K-10 students in the educational program.

Charges: This term refers to any costs for which payment is compulsory.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

For 2024, the school, through the School Council, must determine and advise parents of the anticipated financial costs of the educational programs at the school.

Staff have tried to predict costs for each year level taking into account the programs they are planning for their classes. The charges are estimates only and will not be exceeded nor will they be required to be paid in advance. It is our intention to continue to ask for payment for activities as they occur during the year.

The contribution component is set at **\$60 per student** (This limit is set by the Government).

Additional Voluntary Approved Requests include the Curriculum Enrichment contribution set at **\$35 per student** and the P&C Levy of **\$20 per family** (paid to the oldest student's account).

Contributions will be used to provide additional resources to assist students in their educational programs. P&C levy is used to support initiatives and focus areas that meet the needs of our children. We hope that all families will join our P&C.

Determination of Contributions and Charges for Materials, Services and Facilities in Relation to Educational Programs

VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUESTS

Contribution \$60

Curtin Primary School Council has determined the contribution per student.. These funds will be used to supplement school expenditure.

Curriculum Enrichment Fee \$35

One of the distinctive features of Curtin Primary School is our multi-age learning program known as Coolangahs Kaartidijin. Throughout the year, we also organise a range of whole school (where possible) incursions and activities to support delivery of the curriculum in innovative ways. This charge is intended to cover some of the costs associated with these programs. Please note that additional charges may be requested for specific activities throughout the year.

P&C Levy *per family \$20

The P&C plays an important role in the school by fundraising for school improvements, building community among families and hosting events (such as the Faction Carnival BBQ and Bake sale, 2nd hand book sale). Each year, we pay an annual fee to the peak body representing parents of public schools in WA (WACSSO) to provide public liability insurance for our events and resources to support the operation of the P&C. This levy is intended to cover the cost of the annual fee and support the work of the P&C.

CHARGES

Optional components of the educational programs involve additional costs. If the student does not pay for the optional program, they do not attend or participate in that program but alternative educational programs will be provided.
